

Craft Specialism Roles

Cinematographer	You will work with the director and film crew to create the visual dimensions of the production team’s short film. This will include reading the screenplay and choosing appropriate lighting, angles, framing, and filters to create the mood of the film. Cinematographers are also involved in post-production processes. You will also be an active team member in all production related duties.
Director	As a director you will contribute to all the creative elements of a production and will be responsible for shaping them into a cohesive film. In order to do this, you will need a strong creative vision and the ability to communicate your ideas to a variety of people throughout the production process. This will include your production team, crew, actors and those responsible for producing the film. You will also be an active team member in all production related duties.
Editor	As a film editor you will manage material such as camera footage, dialogue, sound effects, graphics, credits and special effects to produce a short film. This is a key role in the post-production process and your skills can determine the quality and delivery of the finished result. Your voice is also key in the pre-production and production phase of filming. You will also be an active team member in all production related duties.
Producer	Producers work with the entire production team and are responsible for securing the best outcomes in the production of a short film. This will include making sure that your production team are safe and supported (in collaboration with the mentoring team). You will take an active role in managing team members to ensure prompt arrival at sessions and on location. You will also lead on the development of marketing materials for your short film. You will also be an active team member in all production related duties.
Production Designer	Production designers are responsible for the visual concept of the film production. You will identify a design style for sets, locations, graphics, props, lighting, camera angles and costumes, while working closely with the director and producer. You will also contribute to the development of marketing materials for your short film. You will also be an active team member in all production related duties.
Sound	As a sound technician, it is your responsibility to assemble, operate and maintain the technical equipment used to record, amplify, enhance, mix or reproduce sound. You'll identify the sound requirements for a given task or situation in the short film and perform the appropriate actions to produce this sound. You will lead on making sound choices for dialogue/synchronous sound and any added sound such as special effects or musical soundtrack. You will also be an active team member in all production related duties.
