Publication Scheme

Part 1: Introduction

Adopting a publication scheme is a requirement of the Freedom of Information Act 2000. This Act promotes greater openness and accountability across the public sector by requiring all "public authorities" to make information available proactively through a publication scheme.

What is a publication scheme?

A publication scheme is a document outlining the information available from a public authority. Rather than being a list of individual items, it is a guide to the "classes" or types of information the institution is making a formal commitment to publish. The National Film and Television School has adopted the Information Commissioner's model publication scheme and is therefore committed to publishing information in the classes it lists.

Accessing information covered by the publication scheme

The classes of information we publish are listed in Part 2 of the publication scheme. The majority of information can be downloaded from the National Film and Television School website http://www.nfts.co.uk and documents are also available in paper copy from the contacts indicated in the publication scheme. Publications are free unless otherwise stated. Alternative formats may be arranged by special request, but there may be a charge to cover production costs.

Information not covered by the publication scheme

Information not made available through the publication scheme may be requested. Requests should be made in writing and the National Film and Television School will normally have 20 working days to respond. A fee may be charged. Information subject to an exemption in the Act will not be released.

All applications and enquiries should be addressed to the Registrar.

Responsibility for the publication scheme

Overall responsibility for the National Film and Television School's publication scheme is held by the Registrar.
